-Marching Band played at the Big House – had a great time, good experience

-All State Auditions: Sept 26th sign up \$10 fee, Auditions are Oct 29,30 at Saline High School. This year the director of the All State HS Band is Dr. Mary Schneider, Director of Bands at EMU. There will be a concert in January.

-Chair auditions in November. New configuration of bands: Varsity Band (68), Concert Band White (62), Concert Band Purple (64), Symphony Band (65), Marching Band 133.
