Robert Albritton Endowment Fund



Former Pioneer High School Director of Bands, Robert Albritton, was the longest-serving Director of Bands at Pioneer High School — for over 20 years he exemplified the role of the band director as a leader, mentor, and lifelong friend to his students. During his tenure he moved the program forward with an ever-expanding itinerary of festival trips and concert appearances, culminating in the 2000 Symphony Band tour of China.

Through generous donations of band alumni and current band families, and with matching funds from the PBA, an endowment fund in Mr. Albritton's honor was established with the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation. This endowment provides an annual Robert Albritton Scholarship Award to a deserving band student who will be returning to the Pioneer Band program to be used for an outside music camp

or program experience. The size of the annual scholarship award depends on the size and performance of the endowment fund.

Construction scheduled for West Stadium Boulevard in Ann Arbor starting in March

The City of Ann Arbor says the work will take place between Suffolk Avenue and Hutchins Avenue - approximately between Pauline and Seventh streets - and will continue until November.

The project will include:

- *Completely reconstructing the street.
- *Reducing from four to three lanes between Suffolk and Franklin streets, with on-street bike lanes on both sides.
- *New, large capacity storm sewer pipes to provide detention and improved water quality downstream.
- *Removing and replacing existing street trees.
- *A new water main to replace the existing water distribution pipes.
- *New sidewalk ramps and LED energy-efficient street lights.

Detour Route

One lane of westbound traffic will be maintained through the construction zone.

Eastbound traffic will be detoured west on Pauline Boulevard, south on Maple Road, east on Scio Church Road then north on Main Street.

More Information

The city had hosted an informational open house from 7 to 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, Feb. 3 at Trinity Lutheran Church, 1400 W. Stadium Blvd. in Ann Arbor. There was a short presentation at 7:15 p.m. about the project, followed by a question and answer session with the project team.
