As we look forward to concluding another spectacular year in the Bands of Pioneer, we need to take time and congratulate each member of the class of 2010. Thank them for their dedication, and hard work during their careers as Pioneer musicians. We couldn't have done it without you. Here are a few things to place on your calendar so that you don't miss what could be the chance to see your young musician shine one



more time. Sunday, May 16th the entire GRAMMY winning music department will be celebrating our 3rd GRAMMY Gold award with a spectacular concert featuring the Jazz Band, A Cappella Choir, Symphony Orchestra and the Symphony Band. Additionally, the GRAMMY Foundation always provides a special guest to present our department with the \$5000 check and the official GRAMMY Gold Award Trophy. This concert will be the concluding highlight of a truly wonderful year. Saturday May 22nd is the Ann Arbor Public Schools Picnic Pops, on the lawn of Pioneer High School (please hope for super weather). All Bands of Ann Arbor Public Schools will be performing, so come out, spread a blanket and listen to some of finest student musicians in the nation play familiar (and some not so familiar)"lighter" musical selections. On Monday, May 24th Pioneer's Jazz Band will be performing at the Keystone Martini lounge (located in historic Ypsilanti) between sets of the Paul Keller Orchestra. This night is always filled with exceptional music in a great atmosphere. Tuesday the 25th at Huron High School's Meyers Auditorium, the Huron, Ypsilanti, and Pioneer Jazz Bands join forces and raise the roof at the 12th annual (if you can believe it) Jazz Summit! Soon after that, Commencement will follow at Eastern Michigan University's Convocation Center where the Pioneer Symphony Orchestra will be performing.

This years Symphony Band tour to China was a "once in a lifetime" experience. If you haven't done so please check out the Pioneer Band website (http://aapioneerbands.org/) and check out the Symphony Band playing "Stars & Stripes Forever" on the Great Wall of China. Words cannot express how grateful I am to have shared this experience with the students, chaperones, and guests. We all learned so much, not only about this amazing country, but about ourselves. It was truly a life-changing experience for everyone.

During these first few weeks of April I placed students, based on their auditions, into next years Symphony, and Concert Bands. Please make certain you let your Pioneer counselor know of your ensemble selection. In addition we will be reviewing band scholarship applications and start planning for next year. Summer is just around the corner and it is time to think about Band Camp. The Dates are **August 17** – **23**. If you have a child in either Symphony or Concert Band you will need to plan your summer accordingly, as members are expected to attend. If you have a child that is in Varsity Band, I will let students know who was selected to attend Band Camp, in early June.
