All Pioneer Band students are provided with a concert uniform for the school year.

The **Symphony Band** Concert Uniform for men consists of a coat, pants, shirt, cummerbund, and bowtie. Each male student is responsible for providing his own black socks and black dress shoes. Your uniform should not need cleaning during the concert season, but IF YOU FEEL THE NEED TO CLEAN YOUR SHIRT, WE REQUEST THAT YOU HAVE IT PROFESSIONALLY CLEANED. If your tuxedo jacket is new, please carefully cut the paper tag off of the sleeve!

The women are provided with a long black dress and are expected to wear hose and black dress shoes.

The dress or suit you will receive may need to be adjusted longer or shorter. You may make adjustments to length by hemming so the bottom of the dress or pant comes to the top of the shoe and so that the sleeve length of the jacket is correct. Please avoid cutting the fabric if at all possible, but if it is absolutely necessary to cut the dress or pants to shorten, please leave ample fabric in the hem so that it can be lengthened at a future date for another student.

We would appreciate your help in maintaining our uniforms. If you can make minor repairs, such as replacing buttons or fixing open seams, please do so on your uniform.
