

SUGGESTED PACKING LIST - China Tour, 2010



- your instrument(s)
- reeds, mutes, anything else you need for your instrument
- uniform
Ladies: black dress, black shoes, nylons
Gentlemen: jacket, pants, Cumberbund, tie, studs, white shirt, black socks, black shoes
- one pair of socks for each day
- basic undergarments
- at least two pair of long pants
- a different shirt for each day (if you do not plan on washing your laundry; if you plan on washing, maybe half that number)
- a jacket
- zip up sweater (something that can be put over your outfits)
- a poncho
- one pair of gym shoes
- sandals
- dress shoes
- a few pairs of pj's, depending on how often you plan to wash
- a voltage converter (if you plan to bring an electronic device that needs to be charged)

Folding Stands and Clothes Pins/Wind Clips? Yes, performers need them. And all music will need to be taped.

You must be able to carry all of your luggage by yourself.

Carry-on luggage for International flights:

Asiana - 22 lbs. Total width + length + height = 45 inches (115 cm) or less. Max width - 15.5 in (40 cm), max length 21.5 in. (55 cm), max height 9 in. (23 cm). Passengers can carry one more, small suitcase, handbag or laptop.

United - For worldwide travel on any United flight, you may carry on one bag and one personal item such as a purse, briefcase or laptop computer. Your carry-on bag...

- must fit under your seat or in the overhead bin;
- must not be more than 9 x 14 x 22 inches (23 x 35 x 56 cm) or 45 linear inches* (114 linear cm);
- may be required to travel as checked baggage if the bag cannot be safely stowed on your flight

BOTH:

- Liquids, gels and/or aerosols are permitted through security checkpoints worldwide.
- Items must fit in one clear, resealable quart- or liter-sized plastic bag, in containers of 3.4 oz. (100 mL) or less. (For ease of memory, please follow the 3-1-1 rule.) If in doubt, put your liquids in checked luggage.
- 3-1-1 for carry-ons = 3.4 ounce (100ml) or less (by volume) bottles; placed in 1 quart-sized, clear, plastic, zip-top bag; 1 bag per passenger placed in screening bin.

Checked luggage for International flights: (Except large instruments, cleared with the airline ahead of time.)

Asiana - 44 lbs, 62 linear inches

United - 50 lbs, 62 linear inches
